

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-03 (26.7)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 90.04 (DATE OF PAYMENT) OF THE CITY OF GOODVIEW, MINNESOTA CODE OF ORDINANCES BY CHANGING THE AMOUNT OF THE COST OF A DOG LICENSE IF NOT PAID PRIOR TO APRIL 1.

The City Council of the City of Goodview, Minnesota hereby ordains:

(A) It shall be the duty of each owner of a dog to pay the license fee imposed in ' 90.03 to the City Administrator on or before March 1 each year, or upon acquiring ownership or possession of any unlicensed dog, or upon establishing residence in the city. The City Administrator shall cause a notice of the necessity of paying the license fee to be printed in the official newspaper of the city one time prior to March 1, or by mailing the notice to residents in each year thereafter. In the event that payment of the license fee due on March 1 is not received prior to April 1, the cost of the license shall be double the original amount. The owner of a dog newly acquired after April 1 or a new resident establishing a residence after April 1 shall not be subject to the penalty for that year. However, failure of all other persons to obtain the required license is a violation of this subchapter.
