

City of Goodview
City Council Minutes
April 6, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Acting Mayor Dick Ledebuhr at 5:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Upon Roll Call: Acting Mayor Dick Ledebuhr, and Councilmembers Charlie Andring, Steve Baumgart, and Sandy Erdman were present. Mayor J.P. Weimerskirch was absent.

City Staff Present: City Administrator Dan Matejka, Director of Public Works Greg Volkart, Police Chief Kent Russell, First Responders Director Andrew Prunty, and Maintenance II worker Dave Schultz.

Consent Agenda: Councilmember Andring moved and Councilmember Erdman seconded to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. The agenda included both the minutes of the March 16, 2009 regular meeting, and the April 3, 2009 special meeting of the Goodview City Council. After one question from Councilmember Andring about the water billing issue Mr. Ken Spittler had at the March 16th meeting, all voted aye, and the motion carried.

There was no Community Comments/Input.

Councilmember Andring had a question about the properties on Highway 61 just east of the entrance to Cedar Bay. He was informed these two properties are part of Rollingstone Township, and are not in the City of Goodview. Councilmember Erdman gave the Council an update on the cat situation in her neighborhood. She also informed the Council Mr. Rocky Roppe visited her home to voice his opinion that he is being harassed by the Police Department. Police Chief Russell clarified for the Council he did visit with Mr. Roppe about two weeks ago about the condition his property was in. He informed Mr. Roppe if he didn't clean it up, the Police Department will start to cite him. The Chief indicated he recently drove by the property in question, and he believes Mr. Roppe has made vast improvements to the property since the time of the initial discussion.

City Administrator Dan Matejka gave the Council an update on State House File 1262 that was introduced by Representative Drazkowski. This proposed bill deals with the loan the City has through the MN Public Facilities Authority. The Representative indicated he is still working on it, but it doesn't look good. Greg Volkart, the City's Director of Public Works, informed the Council that Winona Excavating will start working again next Monday, the 13th, on the street and utility improvement project for the Saehler-Anderson sub-division. A-1 Excavating is going strong on their part of the project for the Connaughty-Gunderson sub-division. The Police Chief gave the Council an update on how the administrative citation program is going, indicating he has heard nothing but positives from the public as the department has issued seven citations since the inception of the program on April 1.

The Maintenance Department on-call schedule for April, 2009 was reviewed.

The City Administrator explained the purpose of Resolution No. 0818, and how it is in addition to Resolution No. 0814. This basically came out of a meeting the City had with Construction Management Services (CMS), and the requirements they have.

Councilmember Andring moved and Councilmember Erdman seconded that RESOLUTION NO. 0818, A RESOLUTION SETTING "ADDITIONAL" BUILDING CODE FEES FOR 2009 FOR THE CITY OF GOODVIEW, be adopted. All voted aye, motion carried.

Councilmember Andring moved and Councilmember Baumgart seconded to adjourn. All voted aye, motion carried.
